ABSTRACT

Faculty of Teacher Training and Education of Universitas Jambi in Academic Year 2019/2020. The first supervisor is Hidayati, S.Pd., M.Pd. The second supervisor is Robi Soma, S.Pd., M.Pd.

This research dealt with the survey on how English students perceived online learning in speaking class at Universitas Jambi. The study aims to investigate students' perceptions of online learning in speaking class at Jambi University. The formulated research question of this study was: How students perceive online learning in speaking class at Jambi University. This research employed qualitative and quantitative research.
