

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

The e-flashcards was developed based on need analysis and document analysis. The development procedure that used in developing e-flashcards as supplementary material for learning second language acquisition was followed ADDIE Model. The stages of this development started from analysis phase which was analyzed the students' need through questionnaire and textbook analysis, then designing the product based on analysis phase, developing the product step-by-step, and implementing the e-flashcards to the small group students. The stages of this research were terminated until implementation due to the limitation of time and situation because of social distancing.

The product had validated by two experts, which are material, and media experts, the result showed the content validator scored the content 87% and 90% for the usability of product and it categorized as "Excellent". Then, the media validator scored the size 80% and usability 80% which categorized as "Good", then for cover & instruction was scored 90% and for content design scored 93% which categorized as "Excellent". After revised based on validators comment, the researcher continued to implementation. Implementation section had two steps such as students' assessment and interview in order to give the feedback for the product. The result from assessment and interview showed that the media valid to be used as
