
FINDING AND DISCUSSION

This chapter presents findings and discussions of this research to answer the research questions stated in the first chapter, using students' worksheets to improve the effectiveness of English learning at SMP Negeri 17 Kota Jambi. The research results are presented in charts, tables and descriptions, which are described in detail as follows.

4.1. Data Analysis of Questionnaire

Based on a questionnaire that has been distributed through the Google Form link to 76 class VIII students of SMP Negeri 17 Kota Jambi on April 30th, 2021, through the WhatsApp Group of each class VIII student. The following present a pie chart of respondents' answers to each statement in the research questionnaire, and after that the researcher investigated the effectiveness of using student worksheets while study at home during the pandemic.

Based on the diagram, it can be seen that there were 76 student responses to the statement of student understanding when using the English learning worksheet. As for the results, 16 students (21.1%) said they strongly agreed, 36 students (47.4%) said they agreed, 20 students (26.3%) said neutral, and 4 students (5.3%) said disagreed with this statement.

Based on the explanation above, it can be seen that students' understanding when using English learning worksheets is easily understood by students when studying at home.




Figure 4.2 Diagram of student percentage about interest at the beginning of learning used English worksheets

Based on the diagram, it can be seen that 75 students' responses about their interest at the beginning of learning used English worksheets. The results were 16 students (21.3%) said they strongly agreed, 34 students (45.3%) said they agreed, 20 students (26.7%) said neutral and 5 students (6.8%) said they did not agree with the statement.

Based on the explanation above, it can be seen that there is something that makes them interested in using this English worksheet. It is evidenced by the percentage of the diagram as much as 45.3% of students agree with the statement.





Figure 4.3 Diagram of student percentage about variants of activities on worksheets can develop students' abilities during online learning at home.

Based on the diagram, it can be seen that 76 student responses to statements about activity variants on worksheets can improve students' abilities during online learning at home. As for the results, 17 students (22.4%) said they strongly agreed, 38 students (50%) said they agreed, 18 students (23.7%) said neutral, and 3 other students (3.9%) said they disagreed with the statement.

Based on the explanation above, it can be seen that 38 students agree with the statement about the activity variants on this worksheet that can develop students' abilities during online learning at home. It can also be seen in the percentage of 50%.


Picture 4.4 Diagram of student percentage about examining work results and conclusions that students draw after using worksheets while studying at home.

Based on the diagram above, it can be seen 76 student responses to statements about the examination of work results and the conclusions that students drew after they used the worksheets while studying at home. The results were 16 students (21.1%) said they strongly agreed, 26 students (34.2%) said they agreed, 30 students (39.5%) said neutral, 2 students (2.6%) said they disagreed, and 2 other students (2.6%) said strongly disagreed with the statement about the frequency of examination of work results and the conclusions that students drew after using the worksheet for students study at home.

Based on the explanation above, it can be seen that students quite agree with the statement of the frequency of examination of work results and

conclusions that students draw after students use worksheets while studying at home. It can be seen with as many as 30 students (39.5%) saying neutral or quite agree.




Picture 4.5 Diagram of student percentage about inferring and taking important ideas on student material while studying at home.

Based on the statement diagram there are 76 answers from respondents about conclusions and taking important ideas on student material while studying at home. As for the results, 16 students (21.1%) said they strongly agreed, 30 students (39.5%) said they agreed, 26 students (34.2%) said neutral, and 4 other students (5.3%) said they disagreed with the statement.

Based on the results of the diagram above, it can be seen that students conclude and take important ideas about the material even though they are only doing online learning at home.




Picture 4.6 Diagram of student percentage on the application of the contents of the English worksheet in everyday life.

The results were 16 students (21.1%) said they strongly agreed, 26 students (34.2%) said they agreed, 33 students (43.4%) said neutral, and 1 other student (1.3%) said they did not agree with the statement.

From the diagram above, it can be concluded that students quite agree with the statement that students can apply the contents of the English worksheet to things they have seen, done, or thought in students' daily lives. It is evidenced by the percentage results on the diagram as many as 33 students (43.4%) said they quite agree with this statement.




Picture 4.7 Diagram of student percentage about the completeness of the material and worksheet exercises presented per chapter.

As for the results, 12 students (16%) said strongly agree, 33 students (44%) said agree, 22 students (29.3%) said neutral, 7 students (9.3%) said disagree, and 1 other student (1.3%) said strongly disagree.

From the diagram above, it can be concluded that the material and practice questions in the worksheets presented are complete according to the learning per chapter.




Picture 4.8 Diagram of percentage about the worksheets on students' absorption in English online learning.

As for the results 11 students (14.5%) said strongly agree, 30 students (39.5%) said agree, 25 students (32.9%) said neutral, 8 students (10.5%) said disagree, and 2 other students (2.6%) said strongly disagree.

Based on the explanation above, it can be seen that the worksheet on the absorption of students' English online learning. It is evidenced by the percentage results on the diagram as many as 30 students (39.5%) said they quite agree with this statement.






Picture 4.9 Diagram of the student percentage about after studying the material on the worksheet.

The results were 16 students (21.3%) said strongly agree, 29 students (38.7%) said agree, 22 students (29.3%) said neutral, 7 students (9.3%) said disagree, and 1 other student (1.3%) said strongly disagree with this statement.

Based on the explanation above, it can be seen that students agree with the statement that although the learning process takes place online, studying the materials on the worksheets makes students believe that they can succeed in the test. It is in accordance with the results of the diagram of 38.7% which shows students agree.






Picture 4.10 Diagram of student percentage about the of worksheet contents for students.

Based on the diagram above, it can be seen that 75 student responses have been obtained to statements about the contents of the worksheet for students. As for the results, 16 students (21.3%) said strongly agree, 35 students (46.7%) said agree, 16 students (21.3%) said neutral, 7 students (9.3%) said disagree, and 1 other student (1.3%) said strongly disagree with this statement.

Based on the explanation above, it can be seen that the contents of the worksheet are useful for students. It is evidenced by the results of the percentage of students by 46.7% who indicate they agree with this statement.




Picture 4.11 Diagram of student percentage about the material on the worksheet that students do not understand

The results obtained from the diagram are, 9 students (11.8%) said strongly agree, 17 students (22.4%) said agree, 34 students (44.7%) said neutral, 12 students (15.8%) said disagree, and 4 other students (5.3%) said strongly disagree with this statement.

Based on the results of the diagram above, it can be seen that students quite agree with this statement, that there is no material on this worksheet that students do not understand. It can be seen with the percentage of 44.7%, which means that students quite agree.



Based on the percentage diagram above, 76 respondents' answers have been obtained regarding students' enjoyment of learning the material on the English worksheet. The results obtained are, 13 students (17.1%) said strongly agree, 34 students (44.7%) said agree, 22 students (28.9%) said neutral, 6 students (7.9%) said disagree, and 1 other student (1.3%) said strongly disagree with the statement.

Based on the results of the diagram above, it can be seen that students agree with the statement that they are happy to learn the materials on the English worksheet (44.7%).

Based on the percentage diagram, it can be seen that 76 students' answers have been obtained regarding the suitability of the contents of the worksheets with students' interests. As for the results, 11 students (14.5%) said strongly agree, 21 students (27.6%) said agree, 38 students (50%) said neutral, 5 students (6.6%) said disagree, and 1 other student (1.3%) said strongly disagree with the statement.

Based on the results in the percentage diagram above, it can be seen that students quite agree with the statement regarding the suitability of the contents of the worksheet with students' interests. It can be seen from the results of the percentage which shows 50% which means quite agree.

Based on the results of the descriptive statistical analysis in the table above, the standard deviation value is 6.42, the maximum score is 64 and the minimum score is 36, so that a range of 31 is obtained. Moreover, the average score is 47. From the average value, the percentage of the average score can be calculated as follows:

$$\frac{Mean}{skor max} x \ 100\% = \frac{47}{64} x \ 100\% = 73.43\%$$

So it can be concluded that 42 of 76 respondents were given a good perception in using the student worksheets. The results of perceptions can be seen in appendices 3.

Besides, the survey on the use of student worksheets to improve the effectiveness of English learning at SMP Negeri 17 Kota Jambi is also in the effective category with an average score of 73.43%.

4.2. Data Analysis of Student Learning Outcomes

The data on student learning outcomes were taken from mid semester test score and final score of class VIII students of SMP Negeri 17 Kota Jambi.

a. The student's mid semester test score data

Based on the three tables above, the results of the percentage of learning outcomes of SMP Negeri 17 Kota Jambi students using student worksheets in learning English at home during the pandemic, namely: 76.31% (58 students) increased scores, 21.05% (16 students) fixed scores, and 2.63% (2 students) declining score.

4.3. Discussions

The teacher plays an essential role in the learning process, including delivering material so that students, especially English subjects, can well receive the material. Plus, this change in the online learning system causes teachers to be creative and innovative in delivering the material. However, let us look at the students' field at SMP Negeri 17 Kota Jambi. It becomes an obstacle for teachers in delivering the material because not all the students hold gadgets and have the internet to support online learning.

Student worksheets become media that can cover all students. Besides, worksheets can assist teachers in conveying information (knowledge, attitudes, and performance) that cannot be conveyed verbally. This worksheet serves as a student guide in learning and discovering concepts through activities carried out by students during online learning.

Data from a survey questionnaire of the use students' worksheets to improve the effectiveness of English learning at SMP Negeri 17 Kota Jambi. The analysis of survey data of questionnaire distributed to 76 respondents of grade VIII students of SMP Negeri 17 Kota Jambi showed that respondents were given a good perception of the use of worksheets. Questionnaire data also showed an average percentage of 73.43%. It means that the results of the survey questionnaire on the use of student worksheets to improve the English learning at SMP Negeri 17 Kota Jambi while they study at home during this pandemic are included in the effective category.

It is evidenced in the analysis of student learning outcomes at SMP Negeri 17 Kota Jambi in using student worksheets to improve the effectiveness of English learning at home during the pandemic which showed an increase from their mid-semester test score to their final score. It increases can be seen in the results of the analysis of the percentage of 76.31% and the average final score of students has reached 83.19.

Based on the description above, it can be concluded that students' worksheets do not reduce the amount of information they can get from the teacher when they receive information orally at school, using the student activity sheet to guide students who are used for carrying out investigations or problem-solving means that students can improve their understanding by guiding the student worksheet. In line with Prastowo (2011 p.204), worksheets are printed teaching materials in paper sheets containing materials, summaries, and instructions for implementing learning tasks that students must carry out, which refers to the essential competencies achieved. Thus, the teacher does not need time to keep repeating the same material for students understanding. The achievement of English learning competence during online activities can continue to run correctly.

The research results are almost similar to this research in Riza's research entitled, "Meningkatkan Motivasi Belajar Siswa Dengan Penggunaan LKS Mata Pelajaran Kebudayaan Islam Kelas IV MDA Darussalam Pasir Pangaraian". The thesis concluded that there was an effect of worksheets in increasing students' learning motivation after the action. It is evidenced from the results before 49.1% and after the action increased by 70.9%.

Another similar study in Jannati's study entitled, "Penggunaan Lembar Kerja Siswa (LKS) berbasis Keterampilan Generik Sains Terhadap Hasil Belajar Biologi Siswa". In her research, Jannati concluded that there was a significant effect in the use of generic science skill-based worksheets by showing that the alternative hypothesis (H₁) was accepted (t_{count} = 1.87) > (t_{table} = 1.66).

Similar research is also found in Astuti's research entitled, "Efektivitas Penggunaan Lembar Kerja Siswa Pada Pembelajaran Matematika Pokok Bahasan Bilangan Bulat Ditinjau Dari Hasil Belajar dan Pemahaman Siswa Kelas VII SMP Joannes Bosco Yogyakarta". In the results of her research analysis, Astuti concluded that the use of worksheets was effective in learning on integer material this was shown in student learning outcomes of 78.26%.
