### **CHAPTER V**

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

## 5.1 Conclusions

From the results of these data, the researcher found that the answers to closed statements in the questionnaire, most students had a positive perception of English e-learning duirng COVID-19 pandemic. Most of students feel confident when learning English with e-learning and are satisfied with the material provided by the teacher during online learning. Although students feel that learning English with e-learning from home is quite effective for them, 57 (55.3%) out of 103 respondents prefer to learn English offline at school. Beside that, most of students agree that learning English online during the COVID-19 pandemic is more flexible because it can be done anywhere and can also save on transportation costs. But other than that, students feel that holding online learning from home makes them feel less interacting with teachers and other fellow students. The condition of internet access and technology is not the main obstacle for most students, but there are still a small number of students who feel that the lack of internet access and the availability of technology are their main obstacles during online learning.

Students are also motivated to learn English by e-learning and most of them always study and do their homework, even though learning is carried out online from home. They were also get motivation from their parents to always learn English online. And lastly, even though there is no assignment given by the teacher, some students still study from home to increase their knowledge.

# 5.2 Suggestions

# 1. The Teachers

In the learning and teaching process, it is better for the teacher to do more interaction with students so that students will be more enthusiastic in learning English online and do not feel bored. In addition, the available learning resources and discussion activities can also make it easier for teachers to measure the extent to which students are able to understand the material provided.

Researcher hopes students to participate in learning activities during online learning. And always doing homework and studying from home.
