#### CHAPTER V

## **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

This chapter presents the conclusion of this research based on the findings and the discussion in the previous chapter. The suggestions of the study are also presented briefly which is addressed for English teachers and further research in related topic.

#### **5.1 Conclusion**

Future researchers are expected to conduct future research related to the topic with a various analyzes and various ideas such as conducting development research to continue existing research, and can be used to make the materials that fit with the students' needs.
