CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background of the Problem

English is one of language that is used as a means of communication in many countries and among countries in the world. To be able to master English successfully, students need to master four English skills, including Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing. However, Learning English will be easier to learned if students have the right and effective strategies to deal with all English skills.

The important aspect that effect student success in learning is learning strategy. Strategy is a specific method of overcoming, carrying out an activity or task to achieve certain goals. Brown has stated in Rustam, Hamra and Weda (2015), strategies are plans used by humans in a particular situation, those differ within each person. In other words, strategy here refers to the steps used by students to help solve a particular problem or activity that will differ within each student based on the situation. All students need to use learning strategies because learning strategies overcome the difficulties of learning a new language while trying to use language to learn the context. Accordingly Chammot, cited on Ningrum (2018), strategies quiet boardly as procedure that facilitated a learning task. The students have to choose the right strategy to help them in understanding the language skills and get focuson the goals to be achieved.

Related to the statement above, Hakana (2015) has stated that language learning strategies are good indicators of how learners approach tasks or problems encountered during the process of language learning. That is, they become more independent learners and are good at mastering the material. This statement means that students have an advantage if they are aware of their own learning strategies and apply them when they learn a language.

These advantages can make it easier for students to achieve their goals independently than students who do not apply them. This means that students who do not apply learning strategies when they learn English, they may fail to understand the content of what they are learning.

Language learning strategies are good indicators of how students cope with tasks or problems encountered during the language learning process. The existence of strategies in language learning, is needed to deal with the many problems that confront students in learning languages, such as; lack of motivation, lack of self-confidence, limited time to study, lack of friends to practice with, difficulty in mastering vocabulary, grammar, and pronunciation, and many more. According Hakana (2015), language learning strategies provide teachers with instructions on how their students assess situations, plan, select appropriate skills to understand, learn, or remember new input presented in language classes. Line with that Siwijaya (2015) state that, Learning strategies should be used to achieve goals or to solve problems. In other words, it can be said that learning strategies can be used to solve problems in language learning.

Jambi University is one of the public universities in the city of Jambi. As a formal institution, this university also provides English education majors for its students. So, of course language learning strategies take an important position to master, because it will affect students' language achievement. Not only affect their ability to apply them but also help students overcome difficulties and improve their language because they are tools for active, independent, purposeful, and important to develop communicative competence.

Because of all students need to use learning strategies in order to overcome the difficulties of learning, the importance of language learning have been investigated by researcher for years. So, it is important to know what language strategies are used by students in all skills, both reading, speaking, listening and writing. based on the reasons, the researcher is interested in taking this thesis title, namely "An Analysis Of Students' Language Learning Strategies At English
