CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of The Research

Education is one of the essential factors that cannot be separated in life. Every Indonesian citizen is entitled to a proper education. According on law No. 20 of 2003 about National Education System stated that education is purposed to educate the nation's life and to develop Indonesian people. It means that every people in this country have the right to have a good education include the drop-out kids. Education is the gateway to the progress of a nation where a great nation prepares its young generation as early as possible

Children in Indonesia have a better chance of getting a proper education than before. However, around 4.4 million children and adolescents aged 12-15 years are still did not get the proper education.
