

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

According to the paired sample t-test, the conventional media did not affect students' vocabulary mastery. On the other side, the EdPuzzle media had a significant effect on student vocabulary mastery. This research concludes that there is a significant effect on Students' vocabulary mastery after being taught through EdPuzzle media and conventional media using LKS. This could be seen from the T-test result, which showed that the student's mean score on the pre-test in the experiment class EdPuzzle media was 52,19, and the mean post-test was 78,10. Meanwhile, the mean pre-test score in the control class uses conventional media using LKS was 53,90 and the mean post-test was 55,80. In the value sig (2-tailed) was 0.000, which was lower than 0.05. The value of t_0 was 5,018, and df was 40. The t_0 obtained is compared to t_{table} either at 5%. At value 5% t-table was 1,684. Based on the table, it can be analyzed that t_0 is higher than t_{table} at level 5%. In other words, we can read $55,80 > 1,684$. So, the researcher can conclude that H_0 is rejected and H_a is accepted. It means there was a significant difference in students' vocabulary mastery among those taught using EdPuzzle media and conventional media using LKS.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the research that has been conducted with a variety of results that have been obtained, the researcher may give suggestions as follows:

1. For teachers

The materials provided in EdPuzzle should have balanced content and context so that students interested in learning and the material to be conveyed could be well absorbed by students. In addition, the instructions given should be simple and easily understood by students.

2. For another researcher

Other research can use some unexplored parts of the study, such as student motivation to learn to use EdPuzzle, student perceptions when using EdPuzzle, and whether EdPuzzle was appropriate to students' needs and wants. It is also suggested to conduct studies on implementing Edpuzzle in other subject lessons.
