ABSTRACT

One of the areas that already has a HTR business permit is in Teriti Village, Sumay District, Tebo Regency. The Ministry of Environment and Forestry has stipulated a Timber Forest Product Utilization Permit in HTR Forests (IUPHHK-HTR) which was given to the Teriti Jaya Cooperative NO, SK_2887/MENLHK-PSKL/PKPS/PSL.0/5/2018 with an area of 2,516 Ha, on May 11, 2018 a partnership was established between the Teriti Jaya Cooperative and PT. Wira Karya Sakti. Through the Social Forestry scheme, the company partners with the cooperative in the HTR area planted with acacia plants for the company's business interests which is the company's development into the community area by using the gaps in the Social Forestry scheme. Based on the results of data processing and analysis in the study on the analysis of the Relationship between Socio-Economic Characteristics of the Community and the Perception of HTR Development in Teriti Village, Sumay District, Tebo Regency, it can be concluded that the level of public perception of the Teriti Jaya HTR Development is 87.50% or 35 respondents have a good perception. Based on the results of the study, the level of public perception of the socio-economic characteristics of the Teriti Village community on income is 75%, expenditure composition is 80%, education is 92.50%, health is 85% and social interaction is 75%. Overall, the HTR Development of Teriti Village is stated to be high. HTR Development does not have a significant relationship to the socio-economic characteristics of the Teriti Village community, Sumay District, Tebo Regency. The relationship between the perception of HTR Development and community income is 0.120 with a contingency degree coefficient of 0.055 (very low). The relationship between the perception of HTR Development and the composition of expenditure is 0.156 with a contingency degree coefficient of 0.062 (very low). The relationship between perception of HTR Development and Education is 0.929 with a contingency degree coefficient of 0.151 (very low). The relationship between perception of HTR Development and health is 0.022 with a contingency degree coefficient of 0.023 (very low). The relationship between perception of HTR Development and social interaction is 0.063 with a contingency degree coefficient of 0.040 (very low).
