CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This chapter presents the conclusions drawn from the research findings discussed in Chapter IV and offers recommendations for future researchers. The conclusions are based on the study's results, while the recommendations aim to support those interested in conducting further research on related topics.

5.1 Conclusions

This research presents two main conclusions. The first pertains to the types of code-switching employed by Shasa Zania in her tweets, while the second addresses the factors influencing her use of code-switching. Regarding the first point, the analysis revealed that the she utilized tag-switching, inter-sentential switching, and intra-sentential switching. Additionally, the study identified instances where these types of code-switching appeared in combination within a single tweet.

In this study, the researcher identified several factors that influenced Shasa Zania to engage in code-switching in her tweets. These factors included, do not know the word, easiness in the language usage, to add emphasis, and similarities in word. Additionally, the researcher observed that some the tweets were not only influenced by one factors, but could be influenced by more than one factors.

5.2 Suggestion

This study focuses on the analysis of code-switching on Twitter as a form of social media communication. In this regard, the research offers valuable insights for individuals interested in social phenomena from a sociolinguistic perspective, as well as for those in the field of education, including both learners and educators. Maybe in the future there is someone who

wants to do a research about similar topic, and researcher hope that in future research studies continue to explore topics related to code-switching. Future researchers may examine various aspects of code-switching to gain deeper insights into the phenomenon. It is also suggested that future researchers extend the observation period and and add more subject to collect more comprehensive data. Additionally, incorporating interviews into the research process is encouraged, as interview findings can assist in addressing research questions and serve as comparative data alongside theoretical frameworks and analytical results. Depending on the research objectives, future studies may also benefit from employing qualitative methods for a more in-depth analysis.
